

7 - 8 MATHEMATICS CLASS EXPECTATIONS

MATHEMATICS INVOLVES THE STUDY OF NUMBERS AND THEIR PROPERTIES, RELATIONS AND OPERATIONS. IT ALSO INVOLVES STUDYING SHAPES IN SPACE, THEIR STRUCTURE AND MEASUREMENT. THE APPLICATION OF THIS KNOWLEDGE WILL BE HEAVILY STRESSED.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

1. STUDENTS WILL COME TO CLASS WITH THE NECESSARY SUPPLIES TO PARTICIPATE IN CLASS ACTIVITIES AND DISCUSSIONS (books, notebooks, pen/pencil). IF A STUDENT NEEDS TO RETURN TO THEIR LOCKER FOR SUPPLIES, **THEY WILL BE COUNTED TARDY.**
2. STUDENTS WILL SHOW COURTESY TO OTHERS WHEN WORKING IN GROUPS.
3. STUDENTS WILL FOLLOW ALL CLASSROOM PROCEDURES (see back of paper) AS EXPLAINED BY THE TEACHER.
4. STUDENTS OBSTRUCTING OTHERS FROM LEARNING WILL BE DEALT WITH ACCORDING TO FINN'S "3 STRIKES YOU'RE OUT!!" POLICY:
 - a. First Offense--Verbal warning
 - b. Second Offense--Verbal warning and 10 minutes after school.
 - c. Third Offense--Removal from class and parent notificationIf a student is removed from class, they will be expected to make up their missing class time **after school**. Children are expected to receive 50 minutes of math class daily and their behavior will dictate whether they do math during school or after school! Parents will be notified if their child is staying after school so they can make arrangements to pick them up.
5. ANY STUDENT USING PROFANITY, VERBAL OR PHYSICAL ABUSE WILL BE **INSTANTLY** REMOVED FROM CLASS AND REFERRED TO THE OFFICE.
