

A vending machine is defined as any machine that dispenses a product for a designated price.

A playing machine is defined as a machine that requires a level of skill to play in order to win the game

No vending machine or play machine of any type will be placed in any district attendance center without prior approval of the superintendent. If these machines are allowed, financial accountability criteria will be developed by the superintendent who shall supervise, along with the building principal, the management of the machines. A monthly report concerning vending machines or play machines will be sent to the superintendent by each principal having custody of any machine showing all receipts and expenditures for each machine for that particular month. If requested the superintendent shall report to the board the status of the machines and their profitability or lack thereof.

Any profit from any machine will be deposited in an activity fund.
